1. Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Charles Walsey, at 8:10 A.M.

2. Approval of Agenda

After a motion by Supervisor Elsner and second by Supervisor Johnson, the Board unanimously approved the Agenda.

3. Approval of Minutes

By motion by Supervisor Elsner and second by Supervisor Johnson, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Meeting of September 16, 2019.

4. Engineer's Report

The Chair noted that the District Engineer could not attend this month due to jury duty.

5. Operations Manager's Report

The Operations Manager distributed his written report (copy attached) and discussed it with the Board. The Operations Manager introduced Roland Yee of Yee Investments, LLC, a property owner in Section 29. Mr. Poyner explained that Yee Investments' north property line falls within the east-west canal and that the top of bank of the canal is at the edge of the easement. The road for canal maintenance is outside of the easement and within Yee Investments' property. Mr. Poyner says he needs to use this road to maintain the canal. Yee is willing to allow the District to use the road but not to grant a permanent easement. Yee wants to relocate a pump within the canal easement and will need a permit from the District. The District Attorney suggested that the permit could include a condition that Yee give the District a license to use the road for canal maintenance only. This license would not be recorded in the public records and would last as long as the permit was in effect. There would not be a recorded easement on Yee's property. Mr. Yee said he thought this would work but will need to discuss with his attorney and get back to the Board.

Mr. Poyner discussed the process of installing the new concrete box at the north pump station. Due to the budget, this work will be postponed until there is sufficient funding.

6. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer was not present so there was no report this month.

7. Attorney's Report

The District Attorney reminded the Board that the November meeting will be a landowners meeting and election of supervisors. He said that the newspaper ads have been submitted and the letters and proxies will be mailed to landowners today.
