# 1. Roll Call

## 2. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>

After a motion by Supervisor Portnoy and second by Supervisor Duhaney, the Board unanimously approved the agenda,

### 3. Approval of Minutes

By motion by Supervisor Portnoy and second by Supervisor Duhaney, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the Board of Supervisors Meeting of February 21, 2022.

# 4. Engineer's Report

The District Engineer reported. He reported on the Lake Okeechobee System Operating Manual adoption. He stated that the Corps of Engineers released its draft documents on the guidance plan and water control plan and that the Corps will be conducting "listening sessions." Next, he reported on the Loxahatchee River Restoration Project. SFWMD is in the process of drafting rules for protecting water resources in the Lox River system. They are supposed to adopt the rules on April 24. Several impacted entities are expressing concerns. Next, he reported on the Lake Okeechobee water levels. He then reported on the district's water consumption. He and Bobby Poyner are moving forward with recalculating the formula for measuring the water consumption. In addition, the pumps need to be recalibrated.

# 5. Operations Manager's Report

The Operations Manager submitted a written report (copy attached). He reported on the onsite and offsite water levels. He stated that he started the aquatic weed herbicide program. He reported on mowing and fuel. He said he took delivery of 6500 gallons of fuel. He then reported on the status of projects listed in the report. The Treasurer asked which projects were previously authorized and which he has submitted invoices for. Mr. Poyner then discussed the canal bank maintenance between Section 29 & 32 (Item # 11). He asked for authorization to complete this work. He said that it will cost less than the \$5000 indicated. The Treasurer said that the funds are available so he can do this project. Next, he discussed the pipe replacement at 59<sup>th</sup> and Carol Street (Item #10). He has one of the two required pipes, but would have to purchase the second pipe. He wants to replace the pipes when ITID is upgrading Carol Street with millings, since that will shut down the road. He was instructed to find out how much the pipe will cost. The installation cost depends on whether the pipes can be put in wet or if he must install a cofferdam and rent a pump.

## 6. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer said that we ended February with \$484,000. After taking into account operating and other expenses to the end of the calendar year, this leaves approximately \$88,000 for projects.

#### 7. Attorney's Report

The Attorney stated that there was nothing to report. He said in coming months we will need to deal with next year's budget and assessment and filing the annual audit report by the end of June. The Treasurer said that the audit is underway.

#### 8. Comments by Supervisors

There were no further comments by Supervisors.

#### 9. <u>Comments by Public</u>

There were no members of the public present.

### 10. Announcement of Next Meeting Date
